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Margaret MORGAN of Heolhwnt Llanväs Brecon Widow of the late Morgan MORGAN was buried at Bontestyll in the Parish of Llanspythyd in the County of Brecon on the 18th of September 1825.

The above is extracted from the Register of Bontestyll by J:EVANS Dissenting Minister Brecon

The form sent with the surrendered register states that the Watergate Chapel of the Particular Baptists was founded in 1807. The register was sent from the custody of the Minister, John EVANS who had "kept it since the commencement of the first day and out of whose custody it has never been for a single moment". He signed the form on 27 June 1837.
